



Study Abroad Program Caltech

California Institute of Technology



Course = Subject A Course is the **Option/Major degree.** A Subject is a class. The Handbook is the **Subject Catalog**



Study Abroad Program

- Two application rounds a year
 - Semester 1 (February June)(NO)
 - Semester 2 (July November)

** Caltech students can only apply for the Semester 2 round.

- Study for one or two semesters
- Undergraduate and graduate programs available
- Enrol in three or four subjects (courses) from any discipline area
 - Very few class quotas/extra sections are created
- Live in a single room in a 4 person flat in the Student Village at the south end of campus:

Entry requirements

- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Students need to have completed two semesters of full-time study before commencing at Melbourne.
- Some subjects have pre-requisites.
- Students need to meet home institution.

requirements. <u>Caltech students must take 2 subjects at</u> <u>the U Melbourne closest to their Caltech option.</u>

• Caltech students apply through regular study abroad application process for nomination.








You can now also self enrol in over <u>400 undergraduate</u> <u>subjects</u> that don't have prerequisite requirements

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
