Again, make sure all the costs are consistent

Don't Forget! Costs that are frequently forgotten

- Make sure the costs are <u>current/for the summer</u>. Sometimes posted prices are dated and not accurate for when you travelling. Email program to confirm.
- Transportation to and from the airport to program (some programs offer a service, but research and compare with other options to ensure what's best)
- Miscellaneous items you'll need everyday, i.e. laundry, books, etc.
- When looking at airfare, click to the end as if purchasing the tickets to get <u>all</u> <u>the taxes calculated</u>. Look at airfare that is "travel-wise" (only 1 connection max, bigger name carrier, times are conducive to getting around, etc.), not just the cheapest

Notes About Tax Requirements for the Bishop Summer Study Abroad Prize

- The Bishop has been declared a true fellowship. The award for US citizens and permanent residents will not be reported by Caltech or subject to taxes. However, non-resident alien may be subject to a 14% tax rate if there is no tax treaty between the US and their country. Prize funds cannot be used to pay US taxes.
