Timeline & Eligibility

- Application Release: June 1, 2025
- **Deadline:** October 8, 2025, by 1:00 pm Pacific Time
- Eligibility Requirements:
 - Must apply to KHS and a full-time Stanford graduate degree concurrently, or meet certain Stanford-specific conditions (e.g., deferred admission, adding a second degree, or starting KHS in the second year of a PhD)
 - First bachelor's degree must have been earned in January 2019 or later. For military applicants, this window extends to January 2017
 - o **No restrictions** on citizenship, age, field of study, or institution
 - Certain Stanford programs are ineligible (e.g., Honors Cooperative Program, Master of Liberal Arts, JSD, MLS, coterminal programs, or adding an MA/MS in the same discipline)

Getting Started—Step-by-Step

- 1. Confirm your eligibility
 - Ensure your degree timeline and enrollment status align with KHS requirements (as noted above).
- 2. Plan your applications
 - One application to KHS, and a separate application to your chosen Stanford graduate degree program
- 3. Prepare your KHS application (opens June 1, 2025):
 - Online Application Form
 - Resume (1 page)
 - Transcripts & Test Scores (if required by your program)
 - Recommendation Letters
 - Short Answers & Essays
- 4. Submit application before October 8, 2025, 1:00 pm PT
- 5. **Concurrent Stanford application** must be submitted **by your program's deadline**, typically by early December but may vary—for MBA, Round 1 aligns with KHS; others vary

Tips to Build a Competitive Application

- Studentship Concept: KHS values three core qualities:
 - Independence of thought curiosity, creativity, analytical thinking.
 - Purposeful leadership perseverance, ethics, and impactful leadership.
 - o Civic mindset empathy, humility, collaboration, and a dedication to the greater good
- Application Materials:
 - Develop distinct but reinforcing statements for both your Stanford graduate application and the KHS essays – KHS should highlight your broader leadership, vision, and impact; the Stanford application should be more program-specific

- Ensure **test scores** are submitted to KHS if required by your graduate program, by the later of the two deadlines
- Supply strong, tailored **recommendations** that reflect your leadership potential and commitment to service.

Selection Process Overview

- Video Statement Invites: Rolling invitations begin in January 2026 for up to ~500 applicants
- Finalist Notification: Around January 28, 2026
- Interviews & Immersion Weekend: Mid-February virtual interviews followed by in-person group sessions during the Immersion Weekend (early March)
- Final Offers: Announced on March 17, 2026

Additional Practical Advice

- Begin early: Draft your application components well before the summer.
- Seek feedback: Work with campus advisers and fellowship offices.
- **Plan for both applications**: The KHS commitment includes programming beyond your degree—leave bandwidth for that!
- **Beyond funding**: KHS offers not just financial support, but leadership workshops, KHeystone innovation grants, retreats, networking, and experiential opportunities like global travel/study

Summary Checklist

- Confirm eligibility (degree date and application status)
- Plan dual applications: KHS and Stanford graduate program
- Register when KHS application opens (June 1, 2025)
- Prepare and submit application materials by October 8, 2025, 1:00 pm PT
- Submit Stanford program application by its specific deadline
- Draft essays with a focus on the three KHS pillars
- Request and track strong recommendation letters
- If invited, prepare video statement (January 2026)
- Ready for interviews and Immersion Weekend (February–March)
- Expect final decision by March 17, 2026
