Overall DTU has been lovely. The people are very nice, the classes are interesting, and the campus has a lot to offer.

I did not realize how much courses here would emphasize group projects. Most of my courses do not have weekly assignments and instead have one or two group projects that we do. That means you have to self-motivate studying in the week instead of assignments keeping you accountable. The block schedule is also quite interesting, generally having ~2 hours lecture and ~2 hours of problem-solving time in class. The academic system is set up differently, but the adjustment hasn't been too difficult.
